

ABSTRACT

Objective of the research to determine the effect of the use of hand puppet media on the results of learning skills listening to the story of grade II students SDN 148 Pamolongan. The approach of this research is quantitative. Type of the research is a pre-experiment with a one pretest posttest design research design. The research consist of dependent variable that is listening skill of story and independent variable that is media of hand puppets. The population of the research is all students of class II SDN 148 Pamolongan which amounted to 18 students. The instruments used are tests and documentation. Data analysis techniques used are descriptive statistics and inferential analysis on t test. The result of the research is shown by mean pretest score of 70,28 story learning skill and mean posttest 85. Based on inferential analysis on t test showing $t_{count} > t_{table}$ or $11,253 > 1,740$, so H_0 is rejected and H_a accepted. The result indicate that there is a significant effect of using hand puppet media on the result of learning skill listening to the story of second grade students in SDN 148 Pamolongan.
