

ABSTRAK

Tujuan penelitian ini yaitu untuk mengetahui efektivitas kebijakan dana desa dalam pembangunan ekonomi dan infrastruktur di Desa Pattiro Kecamatan Bangkala Barat Kabupaten Jeneponto. Serta untuk mengetahui bagaimana efektivitas penggunaan dana desa dalam pembangunan ekonomi dan infrastruktur di Desa Pattiro Kecamatan Bangkala Barat Kabupaten Jeneponto. Jenis penelitian yang digunakan adalah metode Deskriptif Kualitatif. Data yang diolah adalah hasil wawancara dengan pemerintah desa Pattiro dan Masyarakat Desa Pattiro kemudian observasi dan dokumentasi.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa efektivitas pengelolaan alokasi dana desa dalam pembangunan ekonomi dan infrastruktur menempati kategori efektif terlihat dari rasio efektivitas. Pemerintah Desa diharapkan agar lebih memaksimalkan pengelolaan alokasi dana desa dalam pembangunan dan juga masyarakat turut serta dalam setiap pembangunan desa, mulai dari perencanaan, pelaksanaan bahkan ikut terlibat dalam mengawasi sehingga pengolaan alokasi dana desa tepat sasaran serta pembangunan dapat berjalan optimal.

ABSTRACT

The aim of this research is to determine the effectiveness of village fund policies in economic and infrastructure development in Pattiyo Village, West Bangkala District, Jeneponto Regency. As well as to find out how effective the use of village funds is in economic and infrastructure development in Pattiyo Village, West Bangkala District, Jeneponto Regency. The type of research used is the Qualitative Descriptive method. The data processed is the result of interviews with the Pattiyo village government and the Pattiyo Village Community, then observation and documentation.

The results of this research show that the effectiveness of managing village fund allocation in economic and infrastructure development is in the effective category as seen from the effectiveness ratio. The Village Government is expected to maximize the management of village fund allocations in development and also for the community to participate in every village development, starting from planning, implementation and even being involved in monitoring so that the management of village fund allocations is right on target and development can run optimally.
