SISKA NOFITA DEWI. 105961110316. The Role of Farmer Groups in the Effectiveness of Subsidized Fertilizer Distribution (A Case Study of Farmer Groups in Wonorejo Village, Mangkutana District, Luwu Timur Regency. Supervised by JUMIATI and AKBAR.

This study aims to determine the role of farmer groups in the effectiveness of distribution of subsidized fertilizers in Wonorejo Village Mangkutana District Luwu Timur Regency. Respondents in this study were 20 people from 10 farmer groups in Wonorejo Village, using Purposive Sampling technique. The data analysis used is qualitative analysis using scoring and descriptive methods.

The results showed that the role of farmer groups in the distribution of subsidized fertilizers was high. It can be seen from the results that the average number of respondents scores obtained is said to be high with a total score of 2,56. So the role of farmer groups is said to be high because the farmer groups in Wonorejo Village Mangkutana District Luwu Timur Regency carry out their role in the distribution of subsidized fertilizers. Meanwhile, the distribution of subsidized fertilizers in Wonorejo Village is said to be ineffective because it does not fulfill all 6 principles of right, namely the right type, the right amount, the right price, the right place, the right time, the right quality. Where type of fertilizer provided is not in accordance with RDKK that has been previously discussed that is needed by farmers.
