ABSTRACT

Background: Doctor's Education is known as an Education that requires a long process. Thus, it becomes one of the factors, which makes students tend to experience mental disorders such as stress. Mental disorders in medical students are also influenced by a variety of factors, such as race, gender, marital status, economic conditions, level of parental education, relation with family and others.

Objective: To find out about the relationship between Stress Level to The Graduation of Block Courses in Students of Doctor Education Study Program FKIK Unismuh Makassar Class of 2017-2018.

Methods: This research is a quantitative research with a cross sectional approach that aims to determine the relationship of stress levels to the graduation of block courses in students of the Doctor of Education Program of the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, University of Muhammadiyah Makassar Class of 2017-2018. This research was conducted by stratified sampling method.

Results: This research shows there is a significant relationship between the level of stress to the graduation of block courses in students of the Doctor of Education Program of The Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, University Muhammadiyah of Makassar Class of 2017-2018 with a significance value ($p = 0.000 < 0.05$)

Conclusions: Is a significant relationship between the level of stress to the graduation of block courses in students of the Doctor of Education study program
