The purposes of this research were to, 1) analyze the counseling management strategy for Islamic religious education at Madrasah Aliyah An-Nur Nusa Kahu, Bone Regency, 2) get to know more about the Akhlakul Karimah Development for Madrasah Aliyah An-Nur Nusa Kahu Bone regency, 3) identify the results of implementing Islamic Religious Education Counseling in overcoming obstacles that occurred, especially in fostering Akhlakul Karimah Students at Madrasah Aliyah An-Nur Nusa Kahu, Bone Regency.

This type of research methodology was a type of field research where took place was at Madrasah Aliyah An-nur Nusa Kahu, Bone Regency. In this study, the type of approach used was a qualitative approach.

The results of the research showed that in PAI Counseling Management in Akhlakul Karimah Development had been implemented as well as possible from 2021 and only achieved in 2022 and 2023 although it had flaws. The strategy of PAI Counseling management included planning, implementation, and evaluation. In fostering Akhlakul Karimah students there were more to three aspects of morality 1) Faith to Allah, 2) Morals to oneself and, 3) Morals to others. So that the results of implementing PAI Counseling Management in fostering Akhlakul Karimah: 1) increasing understanding of religion, 2) increasing morals, 3) developing social attachment, 4) being able to solve problems, 5) and self-confidence. The supporting factors were a conducive educational environment, adequate facilities and infrastructure, and solid collaboration. It can be seen that the inhibiting factors included a negative environment, mass media technology, lack of appreciation from parents and students.
