INTRODUCTION

A. Land Banking

Because of the nature of the business of real estate development, it is often necessary to hold land for long periods of time before it can be developed. This is true even in the case of a single-family residential development, where the developer may have to wait several years for the market to stabilize and for the right buyers to appear. In the case of a large-scale commercial or industrial development, the waiting period may be even longer. This is because such developments require significant amounts of capital and time to plan, design, and construct. In addition, they often involve complex zoning and permitting requirements that must be carefully navigated to ensure compliance with local regulations.

Land banking is a strategy used by some developers to manage the risks associated with holding land for extended periods of time. Lower High Court summarised this in dictum as follows:

Section 19(1) of the Human Rights Act 1998 also makes it an offence to discriminate against disabled people. 3.2. *Water exchange with Lakes*

Water exchange between Lake Superior and Lake Erie is approximately 11.0 km³ day⁻¹, occurring via the Detroit River, which flows from Lake Erie into Lake Superior at Detroit, Michigan. Water exchange between Lake Superior and Lake Ontario is approximately 11.0 km³ day⁻¹, occurring via the St. Lawrence River, which flows from Lake Ontario into Lake Superior at the Thousand Islands. The water exchange between Lake Superior and Lake Michigan is the largest water exchange term in the Great Lakes system.

3. COTTON-TEA TAXES




Figure 1 : Effet F1 et effet F2 sur les populations d'une ville (population initiale = 1000).






