

ABSTRAK

Program Studi Magister Pendidikan Sosiologi Pascasarjana Universitas Muhammadiyah Makassar (dibimbing oleh Kaharuddin dan Jamaluddin).

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui 1) Dinamika sosial keluarga mantan pelaku judi online dan 2) Tantangan yang dihadap oleh keluarga mantan pelaku judi online. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif deskriptif. Teknik dalam menentukan informan menggunakan purposive sampling. Jumlah informan sebanyak 5 orang. Teknik pengumpulan data yang digunakan yaitu observasi, wawancara, dan dokumentasi. Teknik pengabsahan data menggunakan member check. Teknik analisis data yaitu reduksi data, penyajian data, dan penarikan kesimpulan.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa: 1) Dinamika sosial keluarga mantan pelaku judi online, yaitu: keterlibatan anggota keluarga dalam judi online menyebabkan gangguan dalam fungsi afeksi, ekonomi, serta peran sosial dalam rumah tangga. Setelah pelaku berhenti berjudi, keluarga mengalami proses pemulihan dan adaptasi. 2) Tantangan yang dihadap oleh keluarga mantan pelaku judi online, yaitu: keberhasilan dalam memulihkan fungsi keluarga. Namun, dalam membentuk identitas sosial baru dilingkungannya belum sepenuhnya pulih, Karena dipengaruhi oleh dukungan emosional, interaksi simbolik yang positif, serta konsistensi pelaku dalam menunjukkan perubahan nyata di lingkungan sekitarnya.

ABSTRACT

This study aimed to examine: (1) the changes in social functions within the family after one of its members ceased to be involved in online gambling, and (2) how the status of "former online gambling offender" is constructed by family members and the social environment. This research employed a descriptive qualitative method. Informants were selected using purposive sampling, with a total of five participants. Data collection techniques included observation, interviews, and documentation, while data validation was carried out through member checking. Data were analyzed using the stages of data reduction, data presentation, and conclusion drawing.

The findings reveal that changes in family social functions after a member stopped engaging in online gambling include disturbances in affective, economic, and social role functions during the period of gambling involvement. Following the cessation of gambling, families underwent a process of recovery and adaptation. Furthermore, the meaning of the status of "former online gambling offender" as constructed by family members and the surrounding community was associated with the successful restoration of family functions. However, the process of forming a new social identity in the wider environment has not been fully achieved, as it is influenced by emotional support, positive symbolic interaction, and the consistency of the individual in demonstrating genuine behavioral change within the community.
