This research aims to find out the students' perception about the effect of Smartphone on students learning outcomes in speaking class English department. This research used descriptive quantitative method. To collect the data, the researcher used questionnaire. The data is gathering from students' through descriptive quantitative. The sample was 35 students' at 5th semester English education Unismuh Makassar. The data analyzed by Likert Scale procedures indicating whether one Strongly Agree (SA) Agree (A) Undecided (U) Disagree (D) and Strongly Disagree (SD). With each statement associated with point value and individual.

This research found that the mean score of the students' perception toward the effect of Smartphone is 80, 88. Based on the questionnaires distributed, the students choose Strongly Agree (SA) 205, choose Agree (A) 365, choose Undecided (U) 66, choose Disagree (D) 28, and choose Strongly Agree (SA) 3.
