

ABSTRACT

The Effect of Utilizing British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) Learning English to the Students' Speaking Accuracy at SMA Muhammadiyah Sungguminasa (A Pre-Experimental Research Design at the eleventh Grade Students). This research aimed to find out whether or not The Effect of Utilizing British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) Learning English can improve the students' speaking skill in learning English at the eleventh grade students of SMA Muhammadiyah Sungguminasa .

This research involved one class of the eleventh grade students of SMA Muhammadiyah Sungguminasa. In this research, the researcher analyzed the data analysis on the students' speaking skill. In collecting data, the researcher recorded by relating story. The recording was held in two phases, in pre-test and post-test. The researcher asked the students to retell about music for pre-test and about covid-19 pandemic for post-test. The researcher used quantitative statistics analyze the data.

The result of analysis showed the use of British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) Learning English make the students more confidence, relax and very helpful in learning English. It also can be seen in mean score of pronunciation (X1) of the pre-test was 48 and in post-test (X2) was 87 and It also can be seen in mean score of vocabulary (X1) of the pre-test was 44 and in post-test (X2) was 84. Then, the result of t-test = 15.013. So, where was greater than t-table (2.160) and it means that there was a significance increase after used British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) Learning English as a media. Therefore H₀ was rejected and H₁ was accepted. Therefore, the used of British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) in learning English at the Eleventh grade students of SMA Muhammadiyah Sungguminasa could improve the students' speaking skill.
