ABSTRACT

This research aimed to identify the use of past tenses at the third semester of English department in Muhammadiyah University of Makassar.

The population of this research was the third semester English department which consists of seven classes. The sample was taken from class A,B,C,D,E,FandG which consist of 64 students. The research was designed as a quantitative research with descriptive design. The speaking test was used to collect the data.

Based on the result of the data analysis, the use of simple past tense was 54 as the mean score. While mean score of students' to use past continuous form was 24 and include in very low category. The mean scorestudents' use past perfect tense 'was 3 as the mean score.
