

ABSTRACT

This research is aimed at finding out the correlation between students' achievement and students' TOEFL score at English Language Department of Makassar Muhammadiyah University. The study was designed as quantitative research with correlation design. The research population was the whole 4th year students at English Language Department and 30 students were involved as the samples. Students' TOEFL score were retrieved from the documents which contained the respondents' score which was published by Language Institute of UNISMUH Makassar. TOEFL test is paper based test which measures listening skill, structure and written expression and reading comprehension. The data were analyzed using descriptive statistic and Spearman Rank-order Correlation through SPSS program. The results revealed that there appeared to be a moderate positive correlation between the two variables which is shown by the Spearman correlation coefficient value of 0.491. It means that, there is a significant correlation between students' achievement and their TOEFL Scores. In other words, H_1 is received and H_0 is rejected.
