ABSTRACT

HAJRAH 2019. Pronounciation Errors Encountered by Makassarese Students at Muhammadiyah University of Makassar (A Descriptive Research at Makassarese Students' of English Department). A thesis English Education Department The Faculty of Teacher Training and Education Muhammadiyah University of Makassar. Supervised by Sulfasyah and Ardiana.

The main of objective of this research identify the dominant errors in pronouncing English consonants made by Makassarese students', and the causes of errors occured.

This research is designed as descriptive qualitative research. In this studythe researcher focused on the Makassarese students' of English Education Program in Muhammadiyah University of Makassar in the Academic Year of 2018/2019. There were 15 Makassarese students as the subject of the research. The instrument of this research were pronounciation test and questionnaire.

The result of the research showed that Makassarese students made some Errors to pronounce English words. The English consonant sounds which were pronounced wrong by Makassarese students are: /d3/, /z/, /tf/, $/\theta/$, /f/, /3/, and $/\delta/$. The result of the research through questionnaire showed that the causes of Errors are: 1. There are many different ways of pronunciation between English and Makassar words 2. Lack of drilling for pronunciation when learning English 3. Difficulty in pronouncing some of English sounds 4. Less motivation to practice the pronunciation of English words.
